



## Announcement by Paul Little AO - A Logistics Giant in the Asian region

“Toll Group now has active business units operating in 55 countries.

“ALC notes and welcomes Paul Little’s stated intention to retain his equity in Toll and to continue as one of Toll’s largest shareholders.

“Paul Little is a foundation member of the Australian Logistics Council and remains a big supporter of the need to have a national organisation in Canberra representing the major national companies in the Australian freight Transport & Logistics industry.

“This is based on the need for strong advocacy on infrastructure coordination and developing national laws to replace the often confusing, complex and inconsistent laws and regulations that apply in the Transport & Logistics industry.

“In recognition of his contribution to Australian business and the Transport & Logistics industry, Paul Little was awarded an Order of Australia earlier this year.

“ALC looks forward to working with Paul Little and the Toll Group team in the years ahead,” Mr Kilgariff concluded
