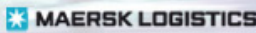
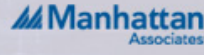

Tim obtains a prominent interest in the supply chain work organisations and has proven his extensive knowledge whilst co-writing the book *Global Logistics and Supply Chain Management*. Tim will present a route map to the logistics workforce of the future and his findings from a research project funded by the Chartered Institute of Logistics and Transport UK.
